

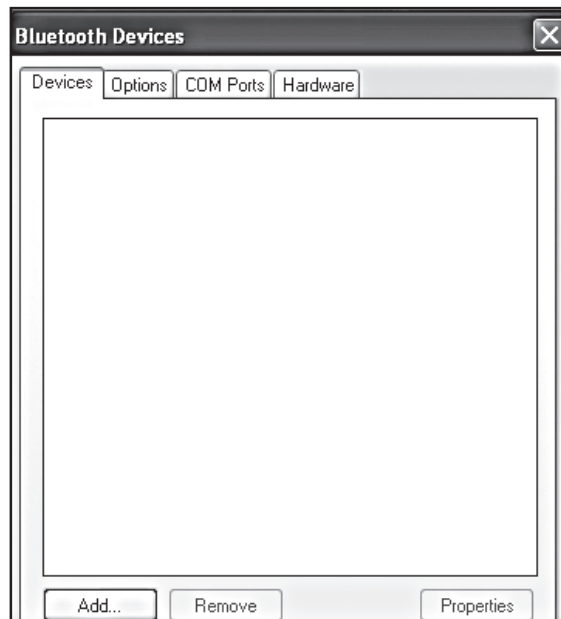


Install Bluetooth in XP - No passkey

1. Remove other bluetooth drivers from the Computer.
2. Restart your Computer.
3. Connect a Bluetooth Dongle or Charging Based Dongle to the USB port of Computer .
4. Your computer will detect a “bluetooth device”, and install the driver automatically, all installation messages will be shown in right side of the task bar.
5. After installing, you will see  in the task bar.
6. Right click  to proceed.



7. Next you will be guided to the Bluetooth Devices window. Click on the “Add” button.



8. Set scanner to “ Disconnect ” using the following barcode.

.E031\$.



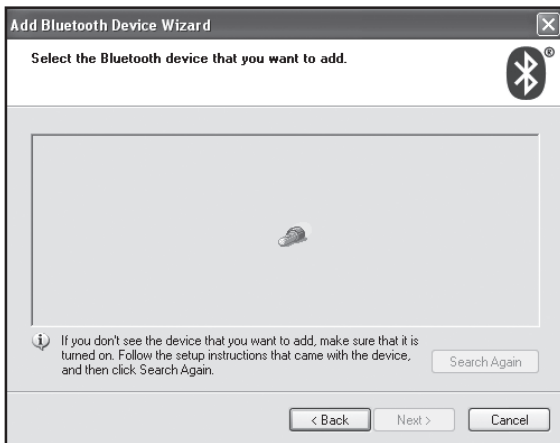
9. Pull the trigger on the barcode scanner, click “ My device is set up and ready to be found” .



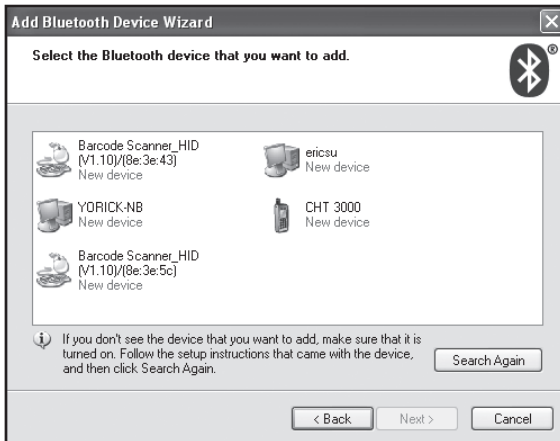
10. Press “ Next” to continue.



11. Then you will come to a window to select device .



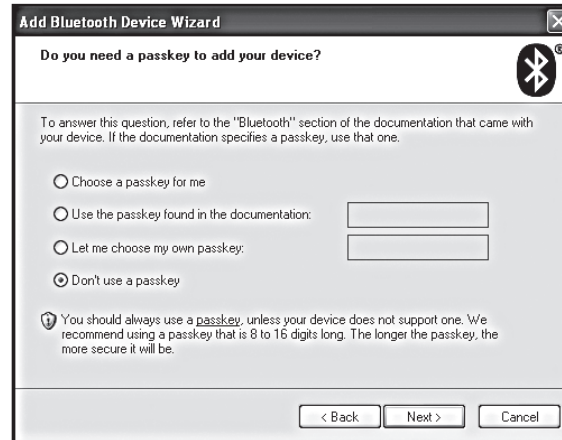
12. Your computer will search for any active bluetooth devices around you, while it searches, pull the trigger on the scanner.



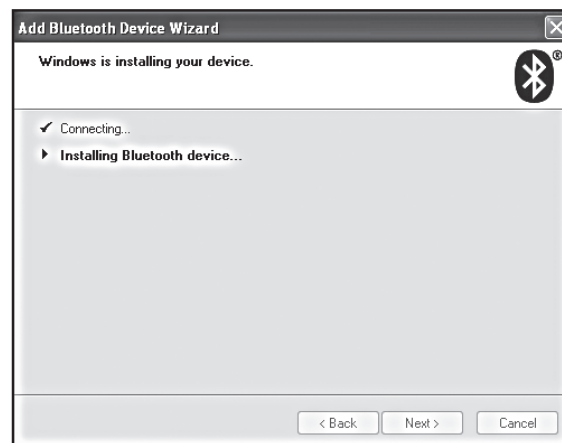
13. Click “Barcode Scanner HID”.



14. Next you will see a window to select the passkey. click “Don’t use a passkey”, and click “Next” to continue.



15. Wait for passkey pairing. Scanner will beep two times for connection, then click “Next”. If not successful, scan default barcode and reset scanner again from beginning.



16. Click “Finish” to end.



17. Open note pad. Scan any bar code, check if the scanner outputs any data to a computer.
